Children attending clubs are reminded that our school rules still apply. If children consistently disregard these expectations, then unfortunately we will have no option other than to remove them from the club.

The cost for each club run by the school is £35. This works out at approximately £2.70 per week for 13 weeks. For those children in years 3, 4, 5 & 6 who would be not already in the choir and would like to join, this will be for the whole academic year. The cost for Choir club will be a donation of between £1 & £5.

All clubs will need to be booked and paid for via [ParentPay](#). The free clubs just need to be booked – no payment necessary. If you do not have a ParentPay login, please contact the office. As places are limited, clubs are allocated on a first come-first-served basis. Once the maximum number of spaces have been taken, the option to book will close. Please note that the office will not be able to book places for you.

As stated above, with the exception of the choir, all clubs will finish, promptly, at **4:20pm**. Please ensure your children are collected on time.

YEARS 3 - 6 - BOYS & GIRLS FOOTBALL CLUB -- With Scott Sweeney - Goal Difference Coach

We are excited to announce that we are now able to offer Years 3 - 6 the opportunity to take part in our after school football club starting on Friday 22nd November. The club is run by Scott Sweeney, who is a parent of children attending the school and a Goal Difference Football Coach. He is first aid trained and has an enhanced DBS check.

Goal Difference is dedicated to improving football experiences through understanding and positive coaching. We aim to inspire, educate and motivate our children using the power of football to improve the lives of the individual, their families and their communities. These sessions will not only develop their football skills but also encourage teamwork, resilience and fair play.
