ACTIVITIES TO START AT 10:20

1. Parents and Carers should bring their child to Greenwich Park on the morning of Sports Day where teachers and staff will be waiting to register them.
2. All children should be wearing their P.E. kit. A coloured band will be given to all children to indicate which house they are competing for.
3. Pupils will need to bring a packed lunch, (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks or products with nuts). A water bottle will be needed for all pupils with additional water provided by school.
4. Please ensure that you apply sun cream in the morning and that your child is wearing a hat.
5. Activities will be run in a carousel, with children organised by class.
6. Pupils must stay with their teacher and class at all times.
7. At the end of the sports activities we will have the running races, including an opportunity for parents and carers and younger siblings to take part.
8. Photographs can be taken but please do not share on social media if other children can be seen in the photo. If anyone is unhappy about this, please contact the school office – email: support@stjosephs.greenwich.sch.uk
9. It is advised that bikes/scooters should not be brought to the park and be left unattended.

After the events children will eat their packed lunches in the park with their class. Families are welcome to sit with their children's class. After lunch, at 1pm, children can go home with a parent/carer if the [attached form](#) has been completed by Friday 16th June. If children are not collected in the park they will return to school with their class teacher and will be collected at normal time.

The day will go ahead as planned unless we receive a severe weather warning. If this happens, you will be notified by the school text system and the children will participate in their own class sports' day in the school hall. Should this be the case, no spectators will be allowed due to lack of space.

Our main focus is that all pupils have an enjoyable day, so let us work together to ensure this.

We look forward to seeing you all on the day to join in the fun.
