Times Tables Rock Stars

Your child has their own account and password for 'Times Tables Rockstars'. It is important that they are able to recall number facts at speed to aid them with their daily maths work. If they are not yet confident this is a vital area to work on with them.



PE

Your child's PE day will be on a **Tuesday (dance)** and **Friday** (outdoor, weather permitting).

Please ensure that your child wears the correct kit on these days.

The PE kit should consist of a white t-shirt, navy or black bottoms and plimsolls/trainers. The school has to teach the National Curriculum and PE is a vital element of this. Participating regularly in physical activity is important to develop habits for a healthy adult life.



Expectations

- ❖ Reading – Your child should be reading at least 5 times a week and this is to be recorded in their reading record book.
- ❖ Homework – This must be completed every week and written up in their homework book, unless otherwise stated.
- ❖ Times tables and spellings – These are tested weekly and it is imperative that these are learnt thoroughly. Year 3 will have 10 spellings each week.
